

REGISTER OF PRESERVED

ELECTRIC MULTIPLE
UNITS AND RAILCARS

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Introduction

This register has been produced to provide a list of all vehicles currently located in preservation in Britain that fall under the description of being either an electric multiple unit (EMU) or and electrically powered passenger carrying railcar, vehicles that have been modified from either of those types but still retain essential characteristics are also included. Only vehicles that are at heritage sites, or privately owned for non-commercial use or at a site that is open to the public are included in this register.

The register is presented in six sections:

- 1) Pre-Nationalisation Companies & Constituents.
- 2) British Railways 25kV OHLE Units.
- 3) British Railways London Midland Region Units.
- 4) British Railways Southern Region DC Third Rail Units.
- 5) Post Privatisation
- 6) London Underground & Constituent Companies.
- 7) Other Railways

Each section is broken down further to list units and individual vehicles that are not part of a complete unit. Subsequent sub-sections are provided to list items by supply system and geographic area of operation.

Each vehicle is listed by class or type, i.e. TOPS class for BR stock or whatever class system was used by its original operator. Then unit number is given which relates to either the unit number carried presently or the last unit number carried in service, in the case of individual vehicles the unit it was predominately formed in during its operating life is shown. The vehicle designation or type indicates what type of vehicle it is and relates to the table found at the end of the register. Vehicle numbers shown are the last number carried in normal service prior to preservation and may not be the actual number the vehicle carries at present. Build date, builder and current location are self-explanatory.

What constitutes a complete unit

For the purposes of this document a complete unit is considered to be:

- Vehicles from a unit formation that ran together in former use on the main line and all are preserved, though not necessarily at the same location.
- Where sufficient vehicles have been gathered at the same location, though not necessarily from an original unit but the intention is to form them as a new unit that is prototypically correct for that type.

What's not included

Any item that is at a private site for non-operational or non-heritage based commercial use and which is not accessible to the general public is not listed in this document. Neither are any vehicles exported overseas regardless of their status with their new owners. Also excluded are items that are stored, pending disposal or in departmental service with a part of the former British Rail or London Underground networks. Non powered trailer car units such as the 4-TC and Gatwick Express stock are not listed as they rely on another traction unit to be operated which need not be electrically propelled. The register does not list any fragments of EMU vehicles that survive such as cab or body sections or underframe only, the complete vehicle body must be extant to be eligible for inclusion. Finally vehicles that have, at some time in their life, been converted to temporarily run in EMU formations but have subsequently been converted back to loco hauled format are also excluded.
